#### **SNAC School:**

The SNACSchool Working Group met by hangout on February 2, 2017, to follow up on December meeting issues and to assess deadlines for projects moving forward through Winter and Spring: completion of the SNACSchool glossary, SNAC timeline, EAC-CPF primer and the SNAC Content Tour, all of which will be components of SNACSchool Lite. The Working Group also made plans for a late April event where we will stage a trial-run SNACSchool experience for a small group of partners. Our experience during the trial run will inform our work for a premiere SNACSchool event at the Society of American Archivists annual meeting in Portland in July 2017. This event will focus on the following SNAC functionality: SNAC UI Administration; Basic and Advanced Searching; Creating SNAC records; Editing SNAC records and Previewing SNAC records.

### **Standards and Editorial Policy:**

Susan Pyzynski took over the role of Standards and Editorial Policy Interest Group Chair from Maureen Callahan. Maureen will continue to serve on the Standards and Editorial Policy Interest Group as an invested and interested contributor.

### Technology:
